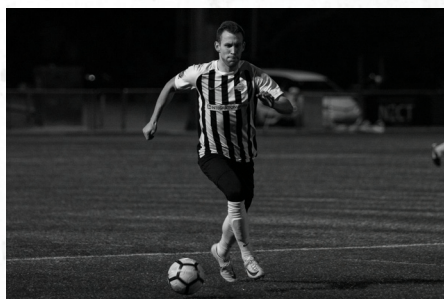

# Reserve's Report

**We would like to offer a warm welcome to the Stokes Valley team and their supporters to Karori Park this afternoon.**

When we met in Round 1 it was a close encounter which we narrowly won 2-1 when Connor Butler scored from a free kick only a couple of minutes before fulltime. We are expecting another tough encounter today.

Last week we played Petone and had to deal with two setbacks early on: (1) Conor Butler injured his knee only 10 minutes before kick-off so Jackson Straugheir started at centre back, and (2) in the 2nd minute Connor Boyd landed awkwardly and broke his collar bone so was replaced by Ramsey Tawngdee. The team took these setbacks in their stride and played the best 90 minutes of the season.

We played well from the start and took the lead in the 21st minute when Cole Hosking-Berge dribbled down the left wing and played the ball into the goal box for Tyler Hornsby to finish. The second goal came in the 45th minute with Hosking-Berge pulling the ball back for Hornsby to get his second just before half time.

We started the second half strong. In the 50th minute Max Winterton cut in from the left and found Rogier Kerbus on the edge of the box, who stepped passed a defender before blasting the ball into the back of the net. The game was sewn up at this stage and Petone never looked like scoring. The backline (Ben Meyer, George Hercus

and Jackson Straugheir) were solid and keeper Felix Nystrom didn't put a foot wrong. The midfield worked hard in defensive transition and snuffed out any potentially threatening situations. Petone only had four shots in the game of which only one was on target.

It was very pleasing to have our fifth consecutive win and it was great to finally get a clean sheet. We are now first equal on points with Brooklyn and Victoria University.

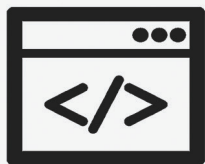
